
Le Rucher Ministries

Taiwan

We traveled east half-way around the world to train an eager group in Taiwan how to debrief. Many of those who were trained are now debriefing in Taiwan, so if you know someone in the area who might benefit from this ministry, let us know.

ARGENTINA

Then we traveled west half-way around the world to train a hand-picked group of mental health and member care providers in Argentina. Now there is a growing network of people and organizations using the Le Rucher model of debriefing.



Congo (DRC)

We headed south to Uganda to debrief a large group of Congolese. The countries were not new to us, but what was new was our team. Our debriefing team including Kenyans and an Ethiopian who we had previously trained. It was a joy to see them participating as full team members, serving their Congolese brothers and sisters.

Community Development & Ethnic Reconciliation

Every year we work with 8 locally-run community development and/or ethnic reconciliation projects that impact

over 9 million people

annually. One project operates in Southeast Asia, but all the rest are in Africa--from the North to the South, with 5 located centrally. All 5 in Central Africa (Kenya, Rwanda and DRC) are combining ethnic reconciliation and community development. The other 3 projects are running excellent community development ministries, changing the lives of thousands of people in their communities. We are honored to serve them in their efforts by raising finances, assisting in



writing proposals, making donor reports, facilitating strategic planning sessions, doing debriefing and a wide range of training or consulting on the field with them. This year we added a possible new country, Cameroon, when we trained over 25 people working in a number of other Christian organizations in the country.
